The paint appears to be holding its integrity. Though there is fading on a few homes who take the most ultra violet light. An inordinate number of homes have dry rot. Jonna has spoken with numerous licensed and insured paint companies. The highs and low to paint a certain model will soon be on the Cascades Residential owners Association website. It may be prudent to bundle with 3 or more neighbors to negotiate a better price. Jonna says many paint contractors are booked months out due to the rain.
- Craig McIntosh moves to move painting to 2020 in hopes people perform dry rot in 2019. Jonna seconds. Motion passes unanimously.
- A letter will go out to each owner indicating what their color scheme will be
- Jonna found overhead lights above front door which would look great.
